Youth Health groundBREAKERs will be appointed on a contract of 1 year ending 2018. Their main activities will include mobilising youth to access health services, facilitating comprehensive sexuality education programmes, events coordination and activation, capacity building and mentoring of volunteers, mobilising communities as well as monitoring and reporting. The successful applicant will be required to fulfil the following primary functions in a youth driven and professional manner:

- Implement loveLife's Youth Health programmes with 10 to 24 year old youth at health facilities, Y-Centres and/or schools in the community
- Mobilise young people to access healthcare services across health facilities
- Map services in the community for youth and refer them to relevant services when or if required

- Recruit and Coach team champions
